Dr. Holloway currently serves as Assistant Professor in the Department of Medical and Clinical Psychology and Principle Investigator, Suicide Prevention Laboratory at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in Bethesda, Maryland. She is also an outpatient therapist in a private clinical practice in Chevy Chase, Maryland. Dr. Holloway's previous positions include Research Associate and Postdoctoral Research Fellow in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Pennsylvania, Research Coordinator in the Department of Neurology at the University of Maryland Medical System, and Research Extern in the Department of Psychiatry at the North Shore University Hospital-Cornell University Medical College. She also served as an outpatient therapist at the University of Pennsylvania Center for Cognitive Therapy.

Dr. Holloway received a BS in Biology and a BA in Psychology, minoring in English Literature in 1994 from the University of California. She received a MA in Pre-Clinical Psychology in 1997 from Chapman University and a PhD in 2003 in Clinical Psychology from Fairleigh Dickinson University. Dr. Holloway completed a clinical internship at Springfield Hospital Center in 2001 and a postdoctoral fellowship in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Pennsylvania in 2004.

Dr. Holloway is the author of several peer reviewed manuscripts, book chapters, and encyclopedia entries. She has presented at numerous symposia, workshops, clinical roundtables, and national and international conferences. She is an ad hoc reviewer for the American Association of Suicidology, VA/DoD Clinical Practice Guidelines, McGraw-Hill, and Wiley Publishing.
