

## **Alan Lee Berman, PhD**

Dr. Berman currently serves as Executive Director of the American Association of Suicidology and Distinguished Adjunct Professor of Psychology at American University in Washington, DC. He also operates a private practice of psychotherapy and psychological consultation. Previous positions held by Dr. Berman include Professor with tenure (1979-1991), Associate Professor (1975-1979), Assistant Professor (1970-1974), and Instructor (1969) in the Department of Psychology at American University. He also served as the Director of the National Center for the Study and Prevention of Suicide at the Washington School of Psychiatry from 1991-1995.

Academically, Dr. Berman received a BA from the Johns Hopkins University in 1965 and a PhD from the Catholic University of America in 1970. He is a consulting editor for *Suicide and Life-Threatening Behavior*, an appointed consulting editor of *Crisis*, an appointed consulting editor of *Archives of Suicide Research*, and appointed chair of the Task Force on International Death Certification Systems. He is affiliated with the following professional organizations: the American Psychological Association, DC Psychological Association, American Association of Suicidology, International Association for Suicide Prevention, and International Academy of Suicide Research. Dr. Berman has authored numerous publications and has spoken at national and international conferences.
