SAUSHEC MOA: Jan 1997



- Created SAUSHEC as the sponsoring institution for all BAMC & WHMC military GME programs

- BAMC & WHMC agree to
 - Provide adequate staff, technical, & budget support
 - Have all trainee assignments, conferences, leave policies, courses, and military specific activities coordinated through the program directors



SAUSHEC MOA: 2001



- Creates the position of Dean, GME
 - ACGME DIO with full authority over all military GME programs in San Antonio and direct access to medical center leadership.

- Resources and staffs office of the Dean
 - Costs split between BAMC and WHMC

- Develops & administers unified budget



SAUSHEC Bylaws



➤ Single GMEC

➤ Meets 11 times / year, alternating locations

➤ Chaired by the Dean

➤ All program directors are voting members

➤ Others: Faculty and House Staff members

➤ Empowered to:

➤ Oversee all aspects of GME Programs

➤ Develop & implement uniform GME policies (Due Process, Resident Grievance, Budget, etc.)



Oversight of SAUSHEC



- Dean reports directly to both medical center commanders
