Victor M. Montori, MD, MSc is a diabetologist and health services researcher. He is the lead investigator of the Knowledge and Evaluation Research Unit and a Professor of Medicine at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. He serves as co-director of the Healthcare Delivery Research Program at the Mayo Clinic Center for the Science of Healthcare Delivery.

Victor is interested in how knowledge is produced, disseminated, and taken up in practice and how this leads to optimal healthcare delivery and patient outcomes for patients with chronic disease. He is particularly interested in the corruption of evidence and healthcare delivery and how corruption affects patient care and outcomes.

Victor is on the Editorial Boards of *Annals of Internal Medicine*, *Trials*, *Medical Decision Making* and is associate editor for the *ACP Journal Club*. He has published a book titled *Evidence-based Endocrinology*. He has over 350 peer-reviewed publications in top medical and specialty journals on his areas of interest.
