01. A SUSPENSION HAS BEEN ISSUED FOR FOL MATL. REASON: BASED ON NEW  
RETROSPECTIVE REVIEWS AND SAFETY STUDIES OF FREE GRANULAR BASED  
HEMOSTATIC AGENTS, DOD STUDIES HAVE DEMONSTRATED THAT WHEN MAJOR  
VESSEL HEMORRHAGE WOUNDS ARE TREATED WITH FREE GRANULAR/POWDER BASED  
MINERAL HEMOSTATIC AGENTS, TREATMENT CAN RESULT IN DISTAL THROMBUS  
FORMATION AND/OR EMBOLIC EVENTS IN DISTAL ORGANS WHICH IS LIFE  
THREATENING. DISP: COMPLY W/MFR/DIST INSTRS IF RECD. IMMEDIATELY  
DISCONTINUE USE. SEE PARA 05 FOR RECOMMENDATIONS. QUESTIONS, SEE PARA

- ALL QUIKLOT (ORIGINAL FORMULA, FREE GRANULAR) BE ASSIGNED ACQUISITION ADVICE CODE (AAC) T.
- REPLACE WITH COMBAT GAUZE NSN 6510-01-562-3325 AS RECOMMENDED BY COMMITTEE FOR TACTICAL COMBAT CASUALTY CARE (COTCCC). IF COMBAT GAUZE IS UNAVAILABLE, USE COMBAT DRESSING AND DIRECT PRESSURE AS PREVIOUSLY ADVISED BY TCCC GUIDELINES.
- IMPLEMENTATION PLAN, INCLUDING SPECIFIC ITEM DISPOSITION INSTRUCTIONS, IS A SERVICE RESPONSIBILITY.

06. PASS MSG TO MEDICAL LOG OFCRS, CMD CHANNELS, PHARMACY, SURGEONS, OPERATING ROOM PERSONNEL, MED STAFF, SUPPLY OFCRS, AND SUPPORTED ACTYS/CTRS.

09. PART TWO FOR AIR FORCE ONLY.

THE AF WILL COMPLETE THE UPGRADE OF THE IFAK (REMOVING THE QUIK CLOT GRANULES AND ADDING COMBAT GAUZE AND AN ADDITIONAL CAT TOURNIQUET) BY APRIL 2010. ALL OF THE AFCENT AF IFAKS HAVE COMPLETED THE CHANGE OVER TO THE NEW IFAK WITH THE COMBAT GAUZE. UNTIL UPGRADES ARE COMPLETED TO REPLACE QUIKCLOT GRANULES WITH COMBAT GAUZE, CONTROL BLEEDING WITH THE PRESSURE DRESSING AND CAT IN THE IFAK, RECOMMEND YOU PACK THE WOUND WITH THE COMPRESSED GAUZE BANDAGE ROLL (ALREADY IN THE IFAK) JUST LIKE YOU WOULD IF USING COMBAT GAUZE (PLEASE SEE THE SLIDES ON THE SABC CBT) AND TRANSPORT THE VICTIM ASAP TO PROPER MEDICAL CARE. QUIKCLOT GRANULES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE IFAK AND TURNED INTO MEDICAL LOGISTICS PRIOR TO ISSUING IT TO A DEPLOYER. THE IFAK WILL NOT BE RESEALED TO FACILITATE INSPECTION AND UPGRADED AFTER THE DEPLOYMENT.
