Major Brian T. Musselman is the Chief of the Human Factors and Operational Safety for the Air Force Chief of Safety, Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Washington, D.C.

Major Musselman graduated from the United States Air Force Academy with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Biology and holds a Master of Aeronautical Science Degree in Aviation Safety from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. Major Musselman has served as an Aircraft Maintenance and Munitions at Holloman Air Force Base and Anderson Air Force Base; an Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps instructor at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Detachment 028; an Aerospace Physiologist at Beale AFB; and a mishap investigator at the Air Force Safety Center providing Human Factors consultation for aircraft and ground accidents and on-site mishap investigation support. In 2007, Major Musselman served as an advisor to the Iraqi Air Force and established the Iraqi Air Force Technical Training School.

Major Musselman is Board Certified by the Aerospace Physiology Society and an Associate Fellow of the Aerospace Medical Association.
