

Caleb S. Cage

Governor Jim Gibbons appointed Mr. Caleb S. Cage as Executive Director of the Nevada Office of Veterans Services in July 2010. Mr. Cage is a veteran of the United States Army, serving from 2002 until 2007.

Mr. Cage was born and raised in Reno, Nevada; he attended the United States Military Academy, West Point, where he studied American History. Upon graduation in 2002, he was commissioned as a Field Artillery officer and was assigned to the 1st Infantry Division in Bamberg, Germany for a three-year tour. During this period, Captain Cage served as a company executive officer and later as a motorized rifle platoon leader in the city of Baqubah, Iraq. Less than a year after returning to Germany, he received orders to return to Iraq. His second deployment was to Baghdad, Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom IV where he served as an Information Operations officer for Multinational Corps-Iraq.

Before this appointment, Mr. Cage served as Senior Policy Advisor for rural and veterans issues for Nevada Lieutenant Governor Brian Krolicki.
