

James Quick, MBA, PhD

Dr. Quick is the John and Judy Goolsby Distinguished Professor and Founding Director of Goolsby Leadership Academy at University of Texas at Arlington. Some of his previous appointments include positions as Visiting Professor at Lancaster University, Visiting Scholar at the U.S Military Academy at West Point, Visiting Professor at Arkansas State University, and Distinguished Visiting Professor at both Colgate University and Marist College. Academically, Dr. Quick holds an AB in Mathematics from Colgate University (1968), an MBA in Management and Organizational Behavior from the University of Houston (1975), and a PhD in Organizational Behavior and Management with a minor in Clinical Psychology/Sociology from the University of Houston (1977). He completed Post Doctoral education in Aerospace and Combined Air Warfare Studies at Air War College (1993), Training for Psychic Trauma and Combat Stress at University of Texas Health Sciences Center at San Antonio (1989) and education in Behavioral Medicine from Harvard Medical School (1985).

Dr. Quick is a Founding Editor of the *Journal of Occupational Health Psychology*, an Editorial Board Member for *Stress and Health*, *Organizational Dynamics*, *Journal of Organizational Behavior*, *Journal of Management*, *Journal of Leadership and Organizational Studies*, *Applied Psychology*, *An International Review*, and *British Journal of Management*. He is also a Federal research grant reviewer for the National Institutes of Health and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and an active participant on many University committees. Dr. Quick has published over 100 books, chapters, journal articles, encyclopedia entries, technical reports, and a clinical monograph, some in one or more of 10 international translations.
