

## **William Donovan, PA-C**

Mr. William Donovan is a former Special Forces 18-D medic who is currently a Physician Assistant working as a medical independent contractor for the Department of Defense and is still actively serving in the CETCOM area of operations. His background includes 41 years of military special operations and medical experience as well as eight additional years of extensive experience in unsupervised/isolated foreign country operations that entail close protection of VIPs, high risk transport operations, and direct support of combat operations. From 1996-1998, he was the Medical Director in support of the Dayton Peace Accord Military Stabilization Program in Bosnia-Herzegovina.

Mr. Donovan graduated from the United States Armed Forces Academy of Health Sciences, in San Antonio, Texas as a Physician Assistance (1983) and from the University of Maryland, Shock Trauma Center (Baltimore, Maryland) fellowship in Traumatology (1995). His certifications include: National Commission of Certification of Physician Assistants, State of Georgia Board of Medicine Examiners, Composite State Board of Medical Examiners, American Heart Association, and Advanced Cardiac Life Support.
