

Master Sergeant Harold R. Montgomery

MSG Montgomery is currently the Senior Enlisted Medical Advisor for the United States Special Operations Command (USSOCOM). His prior position was as the Regimental Senior Medic for the 75th Ranger Regiment and served in the Rangers for over 20 years. His previous positions include Medical Operations Noncommissioned Officer, Battalion Aid Station Noncommissioned Officer-in-Charge, Company Senior Medic in the 1st Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment and Company Senior Medic, HHC, 75th Ranger Regiment. He has participated in multiple deployments in Operation Enduring Freedom (Afghanistan), Operation Iraqi Freedom (Iraq), Operation Uphold Democracy (Haiti), and Operation Desert Storm/Iris Gold (Kuwait) with the 75th Ranger Regiment.

Academically, MSG Montgomery received his BA in Business Management at Saint Leo University. He is licensed by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians and as a United States Special Operations Command Advanced Tactical Paramedic (ATP).

MSG Montgomery is affiliated with the Special Operations Medical Association, the 75th Ranger Regiment Association, the Association of Military Surgeons of the United States, the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians and the National Infantry Association. He is a certified Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support Provider and Instructor.

MSG Montgomery is the recipient of numerous awards, including the Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Order of Military Medical Merit, Order of Saint Maurice, Combat Medical Badge, Expert Field Medical Badge, Expert Infantryman Badge, Parachutist Badge, and the Ranger Tab. He has also presented at several conferences, a peer reviewer for the Journal of Special Operations Medicine, contributor to the 7th edition of the Pre-hospital Trauma Life Support Manual, and is the chief editor of the Ranger Medic Handbook.
