Col Alan D. Murdock currently serves as the Staff Surgeon of Trauma Critical Care at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Prior, he served as the Air Force Representative of Clinical Medicine and Rehabilitation with the Department of Defense Joint Technology Coordinating Group, Washington D.C.
