

## **Senior Chief Duane “Eric” Sine**

Master Chief Sine currently has been assigned as the Senior Enlisted Leader for the Navy at the Joint Special Operations Medical Training Center, Ft. Bragg. In this role, he oversees his staff of SEAL's and MARSOC Corpsmen to ensure that the Corpsmen and Medics are trained in Tactical Combat Casualty Care and provide the best trained Combat medics to Americas fighting forces engaged in “The Long War.” In March 2003, he was selected as one of 82 personnel to start the Marine Corps Special Operations Detachment, the first contribution of forces to Special Operations Command. In this role, he was in charge of standing up and deploying Special Operations Marines in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. He previously instructed at the Joint Special Operations Medical Training Center at Fort Bragg in North Carolina and served as Platoon Corpsman and Senior Medical Department Representative at Camp Pendleton. Master Chief Sine completed Field Medical Service School at Camp Lejeune and Special Forces Medical Sergeant Course at Fort Sam Houston and Fort Bragg.

Master Chief Sine is qualified as an Enlisted Fleet Marine Force Warfare Specialist, USMC Combatant Diver, is a Military Free Fall Parachutist and is qualified to wear the Navy and Marine Corps Parachutist Breast insignia. His personal awards include the Combat Action Ribbon, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (four awards) and numerous campaign medals and ribbons.
