Q: Is NAEMT Tactical Combat Casualty Care Instructor, Coordinator or Affiliate Faculty status a substitute for the TCCC ASM Master Trainer Course?

A: No, The TCCC ASM training mandated by the Secretary of Defense through DoDI 1322.24, Medical Readiness Training (MRT), and DoDI 1322.31, Common Military Training (CMT) has been standardized by the Defense Health Agency (DHA) and is not affiliated with NAEMT.

#### Q: What are the prerequisites to attend the TCCC ASM Master Trainer Course?

- A: 1. Review ASM course materials at <a href="https://www.deployedmedicine.com">www.deployedmedicine.com</a>.
- 2. Complete JKO computer based training DMRTI-US025 "All Service Member TCCC Course Manager Test (15 Mins)" with a 90% or higher score. Please contact the Outlook Org Box below for the current test password.
- 3. Obtain TC3 ASM Course Manager appointment letter from your Commanding Officer or Senior Leadership.
  - 4. Complete the DMRTI TC3 ASM Course Manager Student Registration Form.

# Q: What entity is responsible for the Defense Travel System (DTS) funding for students attending the TCCC ASM Master Trainer course?

A: The student's current command is responsible for all DTS travel funds to Joint Base San Antonio.

# Q: When will students be expected to arrive and depart from DMRTI?

**A:** Students must report to DMRTI No Later Than the day prior to the course start date and expect to depart after 1800 at the earliest on the second day of the course.

#### Q: Where is the course held?

**A:** The majority of courses will be held in one of the DMRTI classrooms on the 5<sup>th</sup> flood or Building 1070, located on JBSA Fort Sam Houston at 4270 Gorgas Cir, San Antonio, TX 78234. If there is not classroom availability in building 1070, facilities at JBSA Camp Bullis may be used.

# Q: Where should students find lodging?

**A:** There are four IHG Army Hotels located on JBSA Fort Sam Houston.
