The WTU reports uses the provided roster of service members and pulls all anti-depressants, anti-psychotics, sedative hypnotics, and controlled substances. The results are specific reports listing all corresponding medications and those service members on those medications.

The Pharmacy Analytics Support Section (PASS) developed the WTU report in order to support the "Warriors in Transition High-Risk Medication Review and the Sole Provider Program."

High Risk Medications are defined here as those medications, alone or in combination, which have the potential to cause significant adverse effects that may be lethal. Included are medications used in psychiatric conditions, insomnia, epilepsy, smoking cessation, and others that have a narrow therapeutic index.

Controlled substances are those medications categorized by the federal government as having a higher potential for abuse or addiction. The included drugs are designated as Schedule II - V according to their medical use, potential for abuse, and safety or dependence liability.

Chronic medications, often referred to as maintenance medications, are those drugs taken on a routine bases and when not provided, have the potential for therapeutic failure.

This database contains Privacy Act information and is subject to criminal, civil and/or administrative penalties to those who willfully misuse this information and violate a person's rights under the Privacy Act. Reasonable and necessary security should be in place to protect this data from unauthorized users.

The Pharmacy Operations Division (POD) developed the Prescription MART (P-MART) program to aid health care providers responsible for the medical care of deploying service men and women of the Army, Navy, Air Force, or Coast Guard. The data is delivered as a menu-driven, Microsoft Access database with individual look-up features and predefined reports designed to serve the needs identified by deploying providers.

The POD also offers a consultative service to assist in the analysis of the data prior to deployment. The assistance provided by the POD has been tailored to the needs of the health care provider and the deploying force. The Pharmacy Data Transaction Service (PDTs) is the data source of this program. PDTs contains prescription data from home delivery, TRICARE network pharmacies and all military pharmacies.

Warriors in Transition Prescription MART (WTU P-MART)

The Pharmacy Operations Division (POD) developed the WTU report in order to support the "Warriors in Transition High-Risk Medication Review and the Sole Provider Program."
