Data Collection Guidance

Determine how you are going to follow up with clinic participants and check their progress. Do they prefer to be reached by email, or would a standing monthly meeting be more effective? Establish a plan for follow up, including dates, times, and methods. You can also distribute brief knowledge checks to assess current practices, establish baselines, and measure progress over time. Below is an example of several data collection options.

When to conduct data collection	Data collection methods
Pre-Training	Determine current naloxone prescription rates at your clinic (check the Opioid Prescriber Trend Report on CarePoint), have your participants complete a pretraining assessment, conduct a brief focus group with your team to determine current practice and knowledge gaps
During Training	Ask participants about their standard practice, determine knowledge gaps, distribute materials
Immediately Post-Training	Assess participants' knowledge gained and intention to change behavior, set goals and plan follow up
Three Months Post-Training	Email or call participants to check in, access prescription or other data and compare to baselines, send a follow-up assessment to participants to determine if behaviors have changed and/or if challenges still exist
Six Months Post-Training	Email or call participants to check in, access prescription or other data and compare to baselines, consider conducting an additional training or even leading your own Train-the-Trainer program
