NONMEDICAL FACTORS INFLUENCING HEALTH: LEGAL INTERVENTIONS, WAR, TERRORISM

Factors or Circumstances That May Influence Health Outcomes; Includes Legal Interventions Involving Violence, Operations of War, Military Operations and Terrorism.

Background

This case definition was developed in April 2023 by behavioral health experts at the Defense Centers for Public Health (DCPH) in collaboration with the Armed Forces Health Surveillance Division (AFHSD) for the purpose of epidemiological surveillance of factors related to legal interventions, war and terrorism that influence health.

Clinical Description

For the purposes of this document, *factors influencing health* refers to nonmedical contextual circumstances that may influence a patient's health status or mental well-being. These factors are typically identified in the clinical setting (i.e., self-reported by the patient or observed by the provider). The presenting problem (e.g., the injury, illness or mental health disorder) is usually the focus of treatment. Factors provide context for the presenting problem and may or may not reflect current circumstances. Factors in this case definition are generally defined by supplemental diagnosis codes in ICD-10-CM categories Y35-Y38 and are used secondary to codes indicating the nature of the condition; most often from categories S00-T88 (injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes).

Case Definition and Incidence Rules

For surveillance purposes, a case of a nonmedical factor influencing health is defined as:

- *One hospitalization* with a nonmedical factor (see ICD9 and ICD10 code lists below) documented in *any* diagnostic position; or
- One outpatient or Theater Medical Data Store (TMDS) medical encounter with a nonmedical factor (see ICD9 and ICD10 code lists below) documented in *any* diagnostic position.

Incidence rules:

For individuals who meet the case definition:

- The incidence date is considered the date of the first hospitalization or outpatient medical encounter that includes a documented nonmedical factor.
- For incident case counts, individuals are generally considered an incident case *once per factor per lifetime*.
- For prevalent case counts, individuals are generally considered a prevalent case *once per factor per surveillance period.*

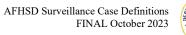



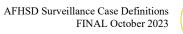

Development and Revisions

- This case definition was developed in April 2023 by the Behavioral Health/Public Health Work Group [BH/PH WG] in collaboration with AFHSD. The case definition was developed based on reviews of the ICD9 and ICD10 codes, the scientific literature, and previous AFHSD and DCPH analyses.
- The case definition was designed to support surveillance and analysis of contextual factors and outcomes related to mental health in military-related populations. Investigators interested in factors and outcomes related to specific health conditions (e.g., heart disease, diabetes, obesity), or specific mental health disorders (e.g., anxiety, depression) may wish to modify the case definition.
- Alternative titles considered for this case definition included "Adverse Determinants of Health," "Stressors," and "Circumstances Influencing Health." The work group felt the term "determinants" implies a factor that necessarily affects heath rather than one whose effect varies by individual and situation. The title "Nonmedical Factors Influencing Health" aligned better with the intent of the case definition and seemed easier to understand than "Stressors" and "Circumstances Influencing Health."

Case Definition and Incidence Rule Rationale

• In 2023, the work group determined that *one* outpatient or TMDS medical encounter with a nonmedical factor would be sufficient to define a case. While factors that influence health are often identified in the clinical setting (i.e., self-reported by the patient or observed by the provider), they are not defined by specific clinical or diagnostic criteria. Therefore, an individual would not require multiple outpatient encounters to confirm the presence of a specific factor.



Code Set Determination and Rationale

- The code set documented here is based, in part, on code sets developed by WHO and the CDC to monitor Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) and on a Veteran's Administration (VA) study that looked at "adverse social determinants of health (SDH)" and their association with suicide risk and morbidity.¹ Similar to the code set used in the VA study, the AFHSD series of code sets includes lifestyle factors, factors related to violence, abuse, and maltreatment and factors related to legal interventions, military operations, war and terrorism. The work group reviewed and modified the code sets to make them more relevant to service members and beneficiaries of the Military Health System (MHS) and to behavioral health.
- Category Y37 (military operations) is included in the code set. The ICD10 codes in this category identify "injuries to military personal and civilians that are sustained during peacetime on military property and during routine military exercises and operations." While the intent of this case definition is to capture factors influencing health related to *intentional* violence–the intentional use of physical force or power to hurt, damage, or kill someone–individuals who sustain *unintentional* injuries or are exposed to violence during routine military operations may experience mental and emotional trauma and behavioral health complications.
- The translated ICD9 code sets for Y36 (Operations of War) and Y37 (Military Operations) are identical; however, the ICD9 codes identify injuries that occur during Operations of War. The category Y37 (Military Operations), which identifies injuries that occur during peacetime on military property, was added to ICD-10-CM; therefore, the translated ICD9 codes are approximate and may be too broad for inclusion in some analyses.
- In ICD10 most injury diagnosis codes have a 7th character (letter) that specifies whether the diagnosis involves an initial medical encounter [A], a subsequent medical encounter [B], or sequela [S] of an injury diagnosis. For the purposes of capturing both incident and prevalent cases, this case definition includes all 7th digit characters. Prevalent cases are often the focus of analyses to understand how many individuals are affected by these factors in a specific timeframe.
- For mapping purposes, only ICD10 codes with a 7th digit (A) are converted to ICD9 and only one corresponding code is included in the code set. Converting ICD10 codes with 7th digits (D) and (S) requires multiple ICD9 codes from various categories, which is not feasible for analysis.

Comments

• For the purposes of this case definition, behavioral health is defined as: "A state of health that encompasses an individual's behavioral, psychosocial, and emotional well-being." Numerous factors may influence an individual's behavioral health. Individuals may or may not have a coexisting mental health condition that meets the specific Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM-5) criteria required for a diagnosis of a mental health *disorder*.
