Job summary Physical Therapist covers positions that involve professional work requiring the application of knowledge of the concepts, principles, and practices of physical therapy for the treatment or prevention of physical disability or disease. Physical therapists plan and carry out treatment utilizing therapeutic exercise, massage, and physical agents such as air, water, electricity, sound, and radiant energy.

Education Degree that included or was supplemented by (1) a physical therapy curriculum approved by the organization at the time the curriculum was completed, and (2) clinical affiliation requirements prescribed by the school.

Licenses or Certificates Must pass a State administered national exam.
