

MHS PRIVATE SECTOR CARE DASHBOARD



The Military Health System (MHS) Private Sector Care Dashboard allows Military Treatment Facility (MTF) leaders to see where their enrolled beneficiaries go for private sector medical care.

Since a large percentage of beneficiaries receive care at private sector facilities, MTFs and private sector providers need to be able to securely share personal healthcare records to ensure patients receive quality care.

The dashboard utilizes the Defense Medical Information System Identifier (DMIS ID), enabling MTF leaders to visualize where enrolled MHS beneficiaries receive private sector care. Once a provider's Health Information Exchange (HIE) has been identified, MTF leaders can initiate an onboarding request to the HIE Office. This starts the process of building a connection to securely exchange patient data.

The HIE Working Group also uses the dashboard data as a factor in prioritizing the order in which the exchanges are onboarded to the HIE.

Key Benefits

- ▶ Identifies top private sector providers in a specified area, allowing MTF leaders to view where enrolled beneficiaries go for care
- ▶ Allows users to visualize the quantity of care provided by private sector providers to all MHS beneficiaries
- ▶ Facilitates the process of onboarding a private sector providers' HIE to enable secure sharing of patient data
- ▶ Helps DHA prioritize HIE connection opportunities

Key Features

- ▶ Sort data by individual or group of DMIS IDs, parent DMIS IDs, HIEs or states
- ▶ Filter results by military status, name or market area
- ▶ View provider or HIE dollar values
- ▶ Export all dashboard data in Excel
