


NMO provides for management of Navy medical/dental data in a data warehouse to support Navy operational commanders and Navy Medicine/Dental personnel (military/civilians/contractors) in managing and reporting individual medical/dental readiness.

In addition, NMO provides logistic reporting for Navy operational units via a web-based reporting interface that allows analysis of the Navy's Authorized Minimum Medical/Dental Allowance (AMMAL/ADAL) data.

NMO provides case management tools that provide an automated means to input and track waiver requests through their approval or disapproval. There is a 230,000 transfer encounter per month on average from the ship to Theater Medical Distribution System (TMDS) for inclusion in the sailor's electronic health record (EHR). This improves a case manager's productivity by enabling them to work multiple cases at the same time on a single application instead of individual cases on separate applications. Users are now able to include up to 3 different type of waivers in one package. It can be a WebWave (for example Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps (NROTC) commissioning), a Radiation Effect Advisory Board (REAB) (if there were any past radiation issues), and an Undersea Special Duty Waiver (Dive, Special Operations, etc.) for qualifying for Undersea duties.

Key Features

- ▶ Enables Navy operational commanders and medical commands to make critical decisions on:
 - Medical/dental readiness issues
 - Medical waiver requests limited duty cases
 - Immunization status (flu shots, for example)
 - Medical waiver requests for USN/USMC officer accessions programs
 - Medical waiver requests for USMC enlistments
 - Medical waiver requests for basic training medical issues for USN/USMC,
 - Track medical issues that may impact US Naval Academy midshipmen service selection process and commissioning, incapacitation of dependent waiver requests, and special duty medical waivers requests for submarines, spec ops, etc.

Key Benefits

- ▶ NMO commanders and staff can answer questions such as
 - Is a unit's medical/dental readiness impacting its deployment status?
 - Can a unit deploy?
 - Is an individual Sailor or Marine medically ready to perform a particular mission or deploy to a specific AOR
 - Is a sailor or marine medically eligible for Special Operations duty?
 - Special Duty Waivers was a manual process before it was automated as a case management tool on NMO
