JOINT SERVICES COLLABORATION PLATFORM



The Defense Health Agency (DHA) Knowledge Exchange CloudPad, formally known as the Air Force Medical Services Knowledge Exchange (AFMS Kx), is a joint services collaboration site.

The Kx contains over 500 distinct sites known as “Knowledge Junctions,” designed to bring together documents, people and other sources of knowledge useful to a particular group within the AFMS.

In addition to being the tool to access the Kx Document Repository, Knowledge Junctions provide many other services that are of special interest to their users - like links to external services, the Virtual Library, specific applications, forums, and links to other important sites within and outside of the AFMS.

The Kx also provides Sponsored Memberships for individuals outside of the AFMS community. Sponsored users have a more limited access to information.

The Solution Delivery Division Web and Mobile Technology Program Management Office sustains Knowledge Exchange CloudPad.
