









The Anomalous Health Incidents Patient Registry collects patient information after an AHI event.



The AHI Patient Registry IS:

-  A database that contains information about an AHI-related event.
-  A system to help the Military Health System understand AHI.
-  Completely voluntary and will not impact your AHI care.
-  Used to improve and advance patient care.

The AHI Patient Registry is NOT:

-  A record of patient care. Only certain information related to your AHI event is included.
-  Sharing your information. Your name and other identifying information will not be shared without regulatory approval.
-  Associated with the award of benefits or disability payments.
-  Necessary to receive medical care for AHI symptoms.

**Providing consent does not guarantee that your information will be included in the AHI Registry.
You and your employer must both agree for your information to be included.**
