


# Health Artifact and Image Management Solution (HAIMS) FACT SHEET

**HAIMS provides health care providers within the Department of Defense and the Department of Veterans Affairs global access to artifacts and images generated during the health care delivery process.**

HAIMS serves as the authoritative data repository for the Service Treatment Record. It provides access to radiographs, clinical photographs, electrocardiographs, audio files, video files, documents and more. The system also transmits an electronic version of the STR to the VA's Veterans Benefits Administration. This transfer streamlines the process for uniformed service members during separation and retirement actions and supports benefits determination.
