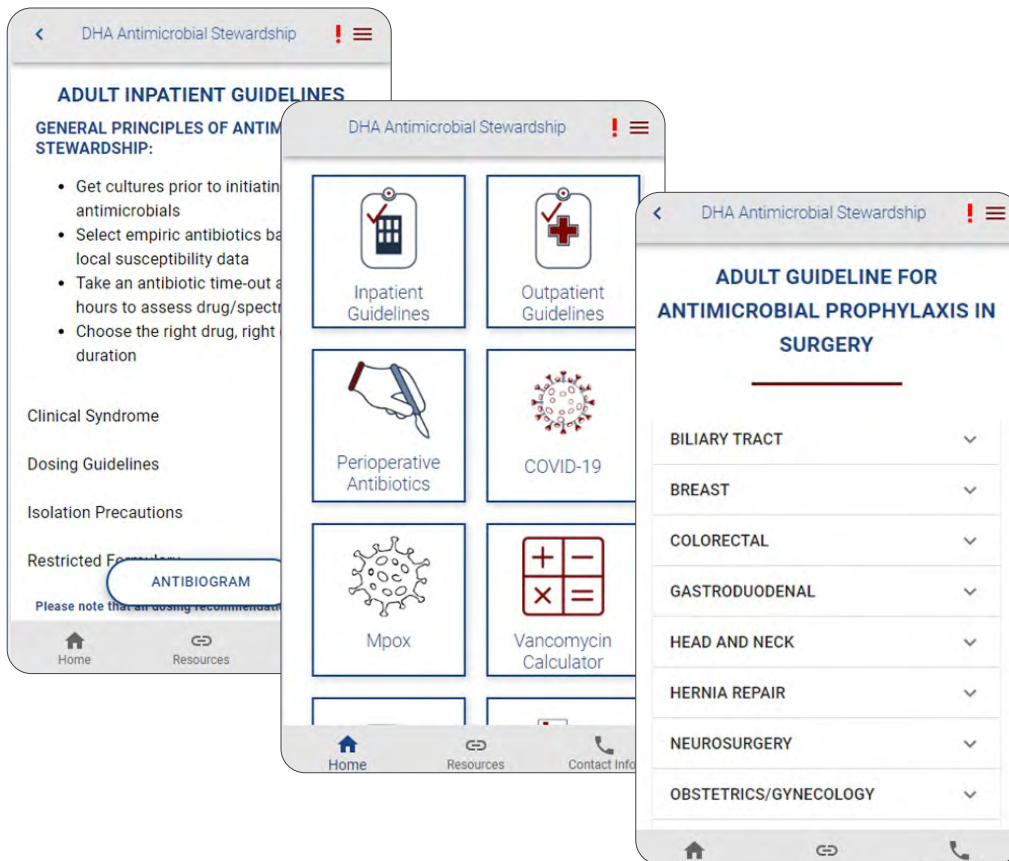


The Antimicrobial Stewardship app contains information on infectious diseases, including guidelines on treating common infections, details on germs found at specific military hospitals or clinics, and resources on correct dosing and antibiotic use before, during, and after surgery.

Antibiotic-resistant bacterial infections are widely recognized as a global health threat. Additionally, it is well known that delayed, prolonged, or inappropriate use of antibiotics is a key driver of antibiotic resistance, contributing to poor patient outcomes and increased health care costs. The app supports providers in managing their patient populations by ensuring timely access to current clinical tools and resources for treating common infections.
