

AWP can be used to print a patient's entire medical record or a subset of the record, eliminating the need to print each AHLTA encounter or result separately.

AWP allows authorized personnel to select the patient, type of data (labs, x-rays, general encounters), and the date range. When the report is ready, users can choose to save in a PDF format or print a hard copy.

The Patient Administration Department creates an AWP report and uploads it to the Veterans Benefits Administration using the Healthcare Artifact and Image Management Solution (HAIMS). This report serves as the base electronic record that makes up a service member's Service Treatment Record. Medical teams using the Military Health System's modern electronic health record, MHS GENESIS, can use AWP to download a copy of the patient's legacy medical record for review.

To maintain AWP capability, sites must request standalone AWP accounts prior to MHS GENESIS activation. Once all sites transition to MHS GENESIS and legacy data is secured, AWP will be discontinued.



Key Features

- Generates a “Report Summary” displaying which section of the record was accessed (allergies, procedures, etc.)
- Flags areas of the report that need attention or additional review
- Users with appropriate permissions have the option to include data marked as “Sensitive” in reports

Key Benefits

- Allows end users to print a patient's entire AHLTA EHR without searching through multiple patient encounters
- Gives the Social Security Administration the ability to validate relevant healthcare information for MHS beneficiaries
