

The DHA MedCard app allows Military Health System beneficiaries to manage prescription pickup authorizations and assists in third party validation requirements. The app also provides users a way to capture and track key medical information for themselves and family members that may be helpful when interacting with the medical team.

Users can manage prescription authorizations in the app by taking a picture of a note authorizing an individual to pick up a prescription on their behalf.

Currently, this application is only supported at the following Air Force Bases: Hill in Utah, Mountain Home in Idaho, Tinker in Oklahoma, Grand Forks in North Dakota, and Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst in New Jersey.




Key Features
