Controlled Drug MART (CD MART)

The Pharmacy Operations Division (POD) developed the Controlled Drug MART (CD-MART) program to assist military providers in the review of controlled substance usage by their enrolled patients. The tool's objective is to assist providers in the identification of patients who have received prescriptions for controlled substances over a given period of time and provide them with an automated process to analyze the data. The data is delivered to the requester is a menu-driven, Microsoft Access database that allows the user to individualize the files with pre-set filtering parameters. The Pharmacy Data Transaction Service (PDTs) is the data source of this program. It contains prescription data from home delivery, TRICARE network pharmacies, and all military pharmacies to include those deployed in Theater and Veteran facilities treating dual-eligible beneficiaries.

Target Population

The report query is designed to focus on patients enrolled to a specific military treatment facility (MTF), to include all enrollment locations under the oversight of the MTF commander. The requester can ask for a single catchment area report that collects data from within the MTF's 40-mile catchment area or they can expand the report to include all the Department of Defense (DoD). In either case, the query will pull data from all points of service retrieving only those prescriptions classified as controlled substances by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Pre-Set Parameters

Data collection has been modified to include the patient's category (i.e. Active Duty Sponsor, Active Duty Family Member, Non-Active Duty Sponsor, Non-Active Duty Family Member or Unknown) in the output and all reports default to include data on all patients regardless of their patient category status. The user has the option of isolating on one or more patient categories.

Based on input from the field, the POD programmed four parameters into the Access database. These pre-set parameters allow the user to build reports based on their local criteria. The four pre-set parameters are Number of Prescriptions (RXs), Pharmacies, Providers and Total Quantity Tablets/Capsules. The user may select any one or a combination of the parameters to build a specific report.
