SUBJECT: Revised Policy for Implementation of Special Pay for Pharmacy Officers

This revises Health Affairs policy 0000010 (January 29, 2001) as follows:

Under "Eligibility:" change the line, which currently reads:

"Is on active duty under a call or order to active duty for a period of not less than one year; May be paid special pay starting October 1, 2001."

To include the words inserted in italics below;

"Is on active duty under a call or order to active duty for a period of not less than one year; and who executes a contract to remain on active duty for a minimum of two years from the date of the contract; (exceptions for those with approved retirement dates may be approved within Service policy); paid special pay starting on or after October 1, 2001."

Also add:

"Note: Anyone extended on active service (voluntary or involuntary) beyond a formally recorded separation or retirement date due to national emergency may extend the contract under which they are currently serving on the date of extension (Stop-loss)."

Under "AWARD FOR SPECIAL PAY FOR PHARMACY OFFICERS:" delete:

", shall be paid in equal monthly amounts"
