



JMESI Community Access

Step 1: Click **“OK”** on the DoD Warning Banner.







JMESI-US001 Bioethics One: Concepts and Principles

Course Description

The first lesson describes ethical issues, provides a model to show the relationship between ethics and law, and discusses the four categories of healthcare ethics: organizational, professional, personal, and bioethics. A lesson highlight is a list of Web sites to obtain current codes of ethics for healthcare executives, physicians, and nurses. The second lesson discusses the concepts of morality, normative and non-normative ethics, ethical theories/philosophies (e.g., utilitarianism, divine law, natural law, etc.), and the implications for professional ethics and public policy. A lesson highlight is a model that provides a framework for ethical justification. The third lesson discusses the four basic ethical principles of respect for autonomy (self-determination), nonmaleficence (avoidance of harm), beneficence (providing benefits and balancing risks/benefits) and justice (equitably distributing benefits, risks, resources, etc.). A lesson highlight is an exercise that applies the four principles to the Tuskegee case (a medical study of untreated syphilis involving 300 black men in Tuskegee, Alabama).
