

This letter is in response to the Joint Explanatory Statement, page 100, accompanying H.R. 83, the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2015, which requested that the Secretary of Defense provide a report no later than 30 days after enactment that delineates transfers of funds in excess of \$10,000,000, and the dates any transfers occurred, from the Private Sector Care budget sub-activity to any other budget sub-activity groups for Fiscal Year (FY) 2012, FY 2013, and FY 2014. Enclosed is the list of transfers with the date of each transfer.

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

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
