Dear Mr. Chairman:

The enclosed report is in response to section 723 of the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 (which added new subsection (b) to section 732 of the NDAA for FY 2013 (10 U.S.C. 1097a note)) requiring the Secretary of Defense to submit a report on the status of reductions in TRICARE Prime Service Areas (PSAs).

On October 1, 2013, the Department reduced the number of PSAs in the United States. PSAs are geographic areas where the Department offers the TRICARE Prime health plan, which is TRICARE's managed care health plan option, similar to a commercial health maintenance organization plan. The reduction impacted about 181,000 military retired beneficiaries of the approximately three million retired beneficiaries enrolled in TRICARE Prime. None of the impacted beneficiaries lost TRICARE health care benefits due to the PSA reduction. All of the beneficiaries impacted could re-enroll in a remaining PSA or with one of the six U.S. Family Health Plans if either was available in their geographic area, or they had immediate access to TRICARE Standard, which is the health plan entitlement by law.

The PSA reduction reduces the cost of administering TRICARE by approximately \$278.0 million from FY 2013 to FY 2018. The PSA reduction did not impact our Active Duty Service members or Active Duty family members. This includes activated National Guard and Reserve members. They all remained enrolled in TRICARE Prime to ensure their access to care and out-of-pocket costs did not change.

Thank you for your interest in the health and well-being of our Service members, veterans, and their families. A similar letter is being sent to the House Armed Services Committee.

STATUS OF REDUCTIONS IN TRICARE PRIME SERVICE AREAS

April 30, 2015

OVERVIEW

The following information regarding the planned and fully implemented TRICARE Prime Service Area (PSA) Reduction is provided as required by section 723 of the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 (P.L. 113-291) (which added new subsection (b) to section 732 of the NDAA for FY 2013 (10 U.S.C. 1097a note)). The statute requires a report from the Department on the status of the TRICARE PSA reduction, the number of impacted TRICARE beneficiaries enrolled in the affected PSAs and other health care options available to the impacted beneficiaries.

On October 1, 2013, the Department reduced the number of PSAs in the United States. PSAs are specific geographic areas where the Department offers the TRICARE Prime health plan, which is TRICARE's managed care health plan option similar to a commercial health maintenance organization plan. The reduction impacted about 181,000 military retired beneficiaries of the approximately three million retired beneficiaries enrolled in TRICARE Prime at that time. A listing of the number of beneficiaries impacted by State is at Attachment 1.

Elimination of the PSAs did not change the TRICARE benefit for Active Duty Service members (ADSM) or Active Duty family members (ADFM) living in the PSAs and enrolled in TRICARE Prime. This includes activated National Guard and Reserve members. All of the ADSM and ADFM remained enrolled in TRICARE Prime, or were enrolled in the TRICARE Prime Remote plan, to ensure their access to care and out-of-pocket costs did not change.

No TRICARE beneficiary lost TRICARE health care benefits due to the elimination of the PSAs. All of the military retired beneficiaries dis-enrolled from TRICARE Prime retained their entitlement to TRICARE Standard and TRICARE Extra and, without having to take any action, could immediately use those TRICARE options on October 1, 2013. TRICARE Standard is the health plan entitlement established by law and formerly known as the "CHAMPUS" plan pre-TRICARE. TRICARE Standard beneficiaries are considered TRICARE Extra plan users when seeking care from a TRICARE network provider, similar to a commercial preferred provider organization plan.

BACKGROUND

PSAs are geographic areas within the United States, designated by the Department, where TRICARE contractors establish health care provider networks to enable provision of the TRICARE Prime health plan option. Consequently, TRICARE Prime has never been geographically available to all military retired beneficiaries; it has always been limited to those living in or within driving distance of an established PSA.

A central feature of TRICARE Prime is the establishment of PSAs in zip codes within forty miles of a military treatment facility (MTF) and, historically by policy, in zip codes within forty miles of all base realignment and closure (BRAC) sites. The Department also allowed the managed care support contractors to establish additional PSAs in areas not located within forty miles of an MTF or BRAC site during the second generation of TRICARE support contracts.

The Department allowed creation of these non-MTF and non-BRAC PSAs because, at the time, TRICARE Prime was projected to be less expensive per capita than TRICARE Standard, the “open choice” health plan option. All of the non-MTF and non-BRAC PSAs were closed by the Department on October 1, 2013, as planned and reported to Congress in the January 10, 2013, White Paper. The current TRICARE Third Generation (T-3) managed care support contracts require establishing and maintaining PSAs only around the designated MTF and BRAC sites. A listing of the MTF and BRAC PSAs by region and State is at Attachment 2.

The T-3 contracts also removed the requirement to maintain the non-MTF and non-BRAC PSAs established under previous contracts. Those PSAs were eliminated from the T-3 contract since they were expensive to maintain and did not serve the primary purpose of a PSA, which is to ensure medical readiness of the Active Duty force by augmenting the medical capability and capacity of the MTFs, especially in a time of war or humanitarian missions when many MTF providers are deployed.

DISCUSSION

Eliminating the non-MTF and non-BRAC PSAs reduces the cost of administering TRICARE by approximately \$278.0 million from FY 2013 to FY 2018. The total amount saved is dependent on several factors: the net change in costs for health care, administrative savings and, most importantly, the number of military retirees who choose to re-enroll (if eligible) in TRICARE Prime via a remaining PSA or with one of the six U. S. Family Health Plans (USFHP). The projected savings were calculated based on a TRICARE Prime enrollee costing the Department approximately \$600.00 more per year than the cost of providing TRICARE Standard. This savings was one of the initiatives the Department took to sustain the benefit and manage the defense health plan budget, which increased from \$19 billion in FY 2001 to \$52.0 billion in FY 2011 (a 174 percent increase), with sequestration imposed budget cuts still possibly happening in future years.

As previously stated, the non-MTF and non-BRAC PSAs eliminated did not augment, and never did augment, the medical capability and capacity of MTFs, which is the primary purpose of a PSA. TRICARE Prime is most cost efficient when enrollees can use a MTF for some of their health care (e.g., surgical procedures, specialty consultations, and laboratory and radiology services), which reduces both health care and administrative costs. As currently required by the T-3 contract, the three managed care support contractors (Health Net Federal Services, Humana Military Healthcare Services, and UnitedHealthcare Military & Veterans Services) are required to establish and maintain PSAs only around the designated MTF and BRAC sites. (See Attachment 2)

The PSA reduction was not a new proposal nor was it the result of any mandated Department of Defense cut in spending. The Department planned this change beginning in 2007 when the T-3 contract request for proposal was released. That contract required bidders to establish and maintain PSAs only at the MTF and BRAC sites, as originally envisioned when TRICARE was implemented in the mid-1990s. The intent was to make the PSA reductions in all three regions simultaneously; however, the reductions were delayed due to contract award

protests and the subsequent staggered transition to the T-3 contract. With the West Region's T-3 contract finalized in FY 2013, the PSA reduction plan was initiated simultaneously in all three regions to correspond with the annual TRICARE Prime enrollment renewal on October 1, 2013.

The impacted military retired beneficiaries had several options to consider regarding which TRICARE health plan was best for themselves and any family members following the closure of their local PSA. The options available were described in each of the four notification letters mailed to the impacted beneficiaries, which included customer service contact information should they have any questions or need assistance. Copies of the four notification letters are at Attachment 3.

The impacted beneficiaries' first option was simply to transfer their TRICARE Prime enrollment to a remaining PSA, if one was available within 100 miles of their home, or to one of the six USFHPs. Transferring their enrollment required a new enrollment form, a waiver of the primary and specialty care travel time standards and selection of a new primary care manager. A total of 34,437 impacted beneficiaries re-enrolled in a remaining PSA: (1) 32,227 of those re-enrolled prior to the October 1, 2013, closure of their local PSA, and (2) another 2,210 re-enrolled as authorized in section 701 of P.L. 113-66, which gave the impacted beneficiaries another one-time re-enrollment opportunity. A listing of the number of beneficiaries who were eligible to re-enroll and who actually re-enrolled by State is at Attachment 1.

The beneficiaries (about 147,000) who were either not eligible to re-enroll in a remaining PSA or who chose not to re-enroll were immediately covered by TRICARE Standard. TRICARE Standard is very similar to a commercial "open choice" health plan, providing health care benefits via a network of providers (TRICARE Extra), via any authorized TRICARE provider, or from any other provider of choice. TRICARE Standard is used by millions of retired beneficiaries, either by choice or due to TRICARE Prime never being available to them based on their home of residence. It can be used as a stand-alone plan, a second payer to an employer's insurance plan, or in conjunction with a TRICARE supplement plan, which pays after TRICARE Standard. In general, TRICARE Standard covers the same medical treatments as TRICARE Prime and gives beneficiaries the most flexibility and greatest choice of providers. The medical providers who accept TRICARE Prime patients usually accept TRICARE Standard, so the impacted beneficiaries very likely continued seeing the same providers. No action was required by the impacted beneficiaries to be covered by TRICARE Standard, as their health plan status was automatically updated in the Defense Enrollment and Eligibility System on October 1, 2013. TRICARE Prime, Standard and Extra all meet the minimum essential coverage requirements of the Affordable Care Act.

To assist beneficiaries with finding providers who accept TRICARE Standard, we tasked the three regional contractors with posting both a "network" (TRICARE Extra) and "non-network" provider directory on their websites. The directories (with a robust search feature) significantly ease the process of finding healthcare providers in the community who have accepted TRICARE Standard patients.

While TRICARE Prime requires an annual enrollment fee (currently \$277.92 per individual or \$555.84 per family), there is no enrollment fee for TRICARE Standard. Instead,

TRICARE Standard beneficiaries pay an annual deductible (\$150 per individual or \$300 per family) and a 25 percent cost-share for medical services (20 percent if using a TRICARE Extra network provider). The pharmacy copayments and the maximum out-of-pocket expense (catastrophic cap of \$3,000 per fiscal year) are the same as TRICARE Prime. Since preventive care health services are now provided with no out-of-pocket expenses under TRICARE Standard, some beneficiaries will have no out-of-pocket expenses during the year. In 2014, a retired family of three spent, on average, \$548.00 to enroll in TRICARE Prime and another \$554.00 in co-payments during the year (\$1,102.00 total), compared to the same family averaging \$1,652.00 in out-of-pocket costs if they had used TRICARE Standard.

Monitoring plan and care satisfaction scores and access to care for beneficiaries using TRICARE Standard is an ongoing activity by the Department's Defense Health Agency (DHA). The DHA calculates and reports satisfaction levels based on surveys sent to beneficiaries who received outpatient or inpatient care. TRICARE Standard beneficiaries consistently report very high satisfaction levels with the "plan", with both the FY 2013 (69 percent versus 57 percent) and FY 2014 (68 percent versus 58 percent) ratings being higher than civilian benchmarks. Similar to satisfaction with the TRICARE Standard plan, satisfaction levels with the health care received when using the plan are also higher than the civilian benchmarks (75 percent versus 72 percent in FY 2013 and 79 percent versus 73 percent in FY 2014). Annually, DHA determines the number of TRICARE participating providers by reviewing the number of unique providers filing claims. The total number of participating providers (network providers and providers who saw at least one TRICARE patient, excluding TRICARE for Life) has risen steadily for more than a decade, leveling off in FY 2014 at 434,300 providers versus 399,800 in FY 2010. (The source for the satisfaction survey scores and number of providers is the FY 2015 "Evaluation of the TRICARE Program: Access, Cost, and Quality" Report to Congress.)

A detailed Beneficiary Education Plan was prepared for the PSA reduction initiative to ensure impacted beneficiaries were aware of their TRICARE options and who to contact for assistance. The plan included specific actions to accomplish each month from January to October 2013. It included letters to the impacted beneficiaries, news releases to the media, web site postings, and ongoing conference calls with the managed care support contractors' customer service teams and the military service associations. The Department's goal was to ensure all involved were aware of the timeline and fully prepared to assist beneficiaries seeking assistance. Two early notification letters were mailed to the impacted beneficiaries between February and August 2013, and, if applicable, a final dis-enrollment letter was mailed to ensure the beneficiary was provided as much advance notice as possible of the October 1, 2013, PSA change. A fourth letter was mailed to all dis-enrolled beneficiaries to announce the one-time re-enrollment opportunity provided by section 701. The letters (see Attachment 3) provided information regarding the beneficiaries' health plan options and customer service contact information should they have any questions or need assistance. There were also continuous updates posted on www.tricare.mil, the TRICARE contractors' websites, other media websites and a beneficiary fact sheet written specifically about the PSA Reduction (Attachment 4). A copy of the Beneficiary Education and Support Services timeline is at Attachment 5.

A total of 419 inquiries were received from impacted beneficiaries. This includes beneficiary inquiries submitted to the President, a congressional office, directly to the DHA, or

to a Beneficiary Counseling and Assistance Coordinator located at a MTF. The TRICARE Regional Office's or the DHA TRICARE Health Plan Division answered each inquiry through a combination of mail, email, telephone calls, and face to face communication based on the urgency of the issue and available opportunities for communication.

CONCLUSION

Senior leadership throughout the Military Health System and at the managed care support contractors was extensively involved with the PSA reduction initiative. Regular meetings were held regarding the process, with routine updates provided by the program office. No TRICARE beneficiary lost TRICARE health care benefits due to the closure of the PSAs. The PSAs were closed on October 1, 2013, as planned and all impacted beneficiaries were mailed three letters advising them of the PSA change and their TRICARE plan options. About 34,000 of the impacted beneficiaries re-enrolled in TRICARE Prime via a remaining PSA, with about 147,000 beneficiaries immediately being covered by TRICARE Standard. Leadership was committed to ensuring a smooth transition for all impacted beneficiaries.
