- Briefing Request: Requests the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs to provide quarterly briefings to the congressional defense committees on budget execution data for all of the DHP budget activities.
- Summary: The cumulative first quarter Operation and Maintenance budget execution rate is 27% percent.
