This letter provides the Department's response to the Joint Explanatory Statement, page 746, accompanying H.R. 2617, the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 (Public Law 117-328), requesting a detailed spend plan for any Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 designated carryover funds.

A total of $\$ 339,579,860.00$ in unobligated FY 2022, Defense Health Program (DHP) Operation and Maintenance ( $O \& M$ ) appropriation funds are available for carryover from FY 2022 into FY 2023. The funds will be used to pay for private sector health care. In the event that private sector claims are significantly lower than projected and all funds are not required for that purpose, any residual funds will be applied to medical facility restoration and modernization projects. The DHP O\&M one percent carryover authority continues to provide the capability to address unanticipated shortfalls during the FY. Examples of the use of carryover funds in previous FYs include private sector health care and sustainment, restoration, and modernization of the Department's medical facilities. The carryover authority continues to support our Service members and their families.

Thank you for your continued strong support for the health and well-being of our Service members, veterans, and their families. I am sending similar letters to the other congressional defense committees.
