- Data sourced from Pharmacy Data Warehouse (PDW), all DoD Pharmacy points of service.
- Report turn-around 24 – 72 hours, 3-5 business days.

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About This Program

- New in January 2020, the DMART reports Deployment Limiting Health Condition Medications –those that may require a waiver, special handling, routine monitoring, or time for dose stabilization as well as injectables and controlled substances.
- As in previous MART tools, this one also reports Controlled Substances and Chronic meds. Chronic meds may also be identified as DLHC but include those for BP, glaucoma, cholesterol control, etc.
- Non-deployment meds include those drugs not available on the CENTCOM formulary that may be obtained through the mail order program (MOP) while in theater. The MOP is the highly successful refill method of choice for deploying SMs. While SRP providers are encouraged to use medications available on the CENTCOM formulary, often SMs are stabilized on particular drugs and should not be switched.

DMART | Deployment Medication Analysis And Reporting Tool - About

DMART | Deployment Medication Analysis And Reporting Tool

This program was developed to aid healthcare providers responsible for the medical care of deploying service men and women. The intent is to identify individuals who might require a more intensive medical review or to alert healthcare providers of medication needs not available in standard deployment packs.

New report as of January 2020.

Deployment Limiting Health Condition (DLHC) medications that may require the service member to receive a waiver before deployment. Medications that require routine monitoring, or a period of time for dose stabilization are included, as are injectables, controlled substances, and medications that need special handling or storage.

Controlled substances are those medications categorized by the federal government as having a higher potential for abuse or addiction. The included drugs are designated as Schedule II - V according to their medical use, potential for abuse, and safety or dependence liability.

Chronic medications, often referred to as maintenance medications, are those drugs taken on a routine bases and when not provided, have the potential for therapeutic failure.

This database contains Privacy Act information and is subject to criminal, civil and/or administrative penalties to those who willfully misuse this information and violate a person's rights under the Privacy Act. This information was provided pursuant to a request from the Senior Medical Officer of this deploying unit. Reasonable and necessary security should be in place to protect this data from unauthorized users.

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Patient Medication Profiles

The Patient Medication Profiles button located on the homepage allows providers to generate a snapshot of a SM's complete drug profile (Rxs dispensed at the MTF, retail, and mail order) over the time period requested for the report. Prescription information includes drug name, drug classification, quantity, date filled and days supply as well as information regarding the drug's inclusion on various formularies. After reviewing the individual profile, if the provider determines the SM needs further follow up, the provider can check "Add to Surgeon's Recall Roster", a separate report that identifies all individuals on the recall roster. If the alpha roster is broken down by individual units, the report can also filter per unit.
